## Item Summary:

The recently formed Pedestrian Project Advisory Committee (PPAC) has been meeting monthly for the past five months to develop a multi-year master plan for pedestrian and bicycle transportation routes via sidewalks and multi-modal pathways throughout the Town of Nags Head. The mission of the PPAC is to assist the Town of Nags Head with facilitating, enhancing, and encouraging safe travel by pedestrians and bicyclists alike and identify improvement options to correspond with relative needs and priorities. An extension of the west side multi-use path along South Croatan Highway has created new opportunities for connectivity between neighborhoods, areas of interest, and through to the oceanfront and sound front public access points. Through citizen input, the Pedestrian Project Advisory Committee provides an opportunity to consider this change in dynamics and identify new pedestrian connections.

A presentation of the committee's findings will be provided by committee member Lynda Frattone and Town Engineer David Ryan, P.E.
