In accordance with Section 14-1 of the Town Code and pursuant to NCGS 166A-19.31, the Mayor has declared a State of Emergency in the Town of Nags Head in order to limit the spread of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) and to help protect the health and well-being of residents and visitors in the Town of Nags Head. I hereby prohibit mass gatherings in the Town of Nags Head as follows:



A mass gathering is defined as any event or convening that brings together more than fifty (50) persons in a single room or single space at the same time, such as an auditorium, stadium, arena, large conference room, meeting hall, theater, or any other confined indoor or outdoor space. A mass gathering does not include normal operations at airports, bus and train stations, medical facilities, libraries, shopping malls and centers, or other spaces where more than fifty (50) persons are gathered. It also does not include office environments, restaurants, factories, grocery stores or other retail establishments.
- c. Pursuant to NCGS 166A-19.31, the provision of this section shall be enforced by state and local law enforcement officers.
- d. Violations of this section or orders issued pursuant to NCGS 166A-19.31 may be subject to prosecution and is punishable as a Class 2 misdemeanor.


