



AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES
OF THE TOWN OF NAGS HEAD, NORTH CAROLINA


BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Nags Head, North Carolina, that the Code of Ordinances shall be amended as follows:

PART I. That **Section 48-405(c)(2)(t), Hotels as a Conditional Use within the CR, Commercial Residential Zoning District**, be amended as follows:


- t. Hotel sites may include the following accessory uses: fishing pier (with CAMA authorization), restaurant, indoor entertainment facility, indoor public assembly, retail, and office and on-site rental of beach chairs and umbrellas provided that:
 - i. Storage of such items shall be located westward of the first line of stable natural vegetation and shall not be visible from the beach.
 - ii. Beach chairs and umbrella's to be placed upon the beach shall contain no commercial signage. Any other signage shall not be visible from the beach.
 - iii. Placement of beach chairs and umbrella's upon the beach shall not restrict or impede the flow of vehicular, pedestrian or emergency services traffic.
 - iv. All exchange of money for rental transactions shall occur inside the principal structure, i.e. the hotel.
 - v. Rentals shall be limited to hotel patrons.

PART II. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

PART III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the 2nd day of March, 2011.
