



A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF SENATE BILL 641

WHEREAS, to accommodate the economic development opportunities that growth brings, local governments must have revenues to provide required services such as schools, water, street construction and maintenance, lighting, police and fire protection; AND

WHEREAS, without the use of impact fees as a source of revenue, critical infrastructure and services would be eliminated; AND

WHEREAS, on April 4, 2017, Senate Bill 641, entitled "An Act To Provide For Uniform Authority To Implement System Development Fees For Public Water And Sewer Systems In North Carolina" was filed for consideration by the North Carolina General Assembly; AND

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 641 provides a formula for calculating uniform impact fees across the State; AND

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 641 repeals all local acts related to impact fees.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that we, the Town of Nags Head Board of Commissioners, express our support of Senate Bill 641 which makes the authority for impact fees uniform across the State and preserves the ability of local governments to provide critical infrastructure and services to their communities.
