



RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF A TOWN OF NAGS HEAD APPLICATION FOR A PLAY TOGETHER CONSTRUCTION GRANT FOR ACCESSIBLE PLAYGROUNDS FROM TRILLIUM HEALTH RESOURCES FOR PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT AND RELATED INFRASTRUCTURE AT THE DOWDY PARK PROPERTY

WHEREAS, Trillium Health Resources is offering construction grants to be used towards the purchase of inclusive playgrounds and/or playground equipment and related infrastructure, and;

WHEREAS, the Town of Nags Head currently owns, operates, and maintains public playgrounds for children and desires to make or offer those areas accessible and functional to individuals with special needs and to individuals in wheelchairs, and;

WHEREAS, the Town of Nags Head has developed a master conceptual plan for the Dowdy Park project to develop a community park which will incorporate playground equipment in both formal and informal settings, and;

WHEREAS, the Town of Nags Head intends to make application to Trillium Health Resources for purchase and installation of playground equipment at the Dowdy Park property in conjunction with Phase I development of the Park.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Nags Head Board of Commissioners authorizes staff to submit an application to Trillium Health Resources for a Play Together Construction Grant for Accessible Playgrounds for the purchase and installation of playground equipment at the Dowdy Park property in an amount not exceeding \$750,000. It is understood that the Town of Nags Head hereby agrees to comply with all the rules and regulations concerning the Trillium Health Resources Play Together Construction Grant for Accessible Playground Grants Program.
