**RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT
OF THE EXTENSION OF THE OCEAN OUTFALL
LOCATED IN THE 2400 BLOCK OF S VIRGINIA DARE TRAIL
IN NAGS HEAD, NORTH CAROLINA**

WHEREAS, the Town of Nags Head recognizes that our natural environment is an integral part of our community and must be considered in all decisions,

WHEREAS, the health of our natural environment relies, in part, on a viable, functioning stormwater drainage system,

WHEREAS, the NCDOT outfalls located in Nags Head are important cogs in the wheel of the Town's drainage system,

WHEREAS, the Town recognizes that building and maintaining partnerships ensures the success of our community,

WHEREAS, the Town of Nags Head and NCDOT have partnered for many years to ensure the functionality of these outfalls,

WHEREAS, most recently our two organizations worked together to extend three outfalls in Nags Head as part of the Town's 2011 beach nourishment project,

WHEREAS, the extension of the ocean outfall in the 2400 block of S Virginia Dare Trail, also known as the Red Drum ocean outfall, will improve stormwater flow and protect property and roadways.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Nags Head Board of Commissioners hereby expresses interest in working with the North Carolina Department of Transportation to extend the ocean outfall located in the 2400 block of S Virginia Dare Trail in order to maintain a healthy and viable stormwater drainage system in the Town.
