



**RESOLUTION REQUESTING DARE COUNTY ASSIGN  
FEDERAL BEACH NOURISHMENT PROJECT EASEMENTS  
TO THE TOWN OF NAGS HEAD**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Nags Head Board of Commissioners has determined a need for action in order to protect structures of historic significance, maintain tax and economic base, protect town infrastructure including facilities for public recreational access; AND

**WHEREAS**, the Board and has determined that the construction of a beach nourishment project will benefit all Nags Head residents; AND

**WHEREAS**, the Board initiated action at its December 27, 2010 meeting to move forward and utilize its occupancy tax revenue stream to procure a bond to pay for the unfunded balance of its beach nourishment project; AND

**WHEREAS**, the first step in the process to move forward is to procure easements from the oceanfront property owners.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Nags Head Board of Commissioners does hereby request that the County of Dare assign their right, title, and interest in the easements procured for the Federal Beach Nourishment Project – for the addresses listed as follows:

From 5317 S Virginia Dare Trail to 8827 S Old Oregon Inlet Road - for use on behalf of the Town of Nags Head's Local Beach Nourishment Project.
