



**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES
 OF THE TOWN OF NAGS HEAD, NORTH CAROLINA**

WHEREAS, The Town desires to build an economy based on family tourism; and

WHEREAS, The Town works to support local business owners; and

WHEREAS, the Town finds that beach nourishment and a reduced pattern of fishing from the pier has changed parking demand for those fishing from the pier; and

WHEREAS, the Town finds that these text amendments are consistent with the goals, objectives and policies of the Town's adopted Land Use Plan, and that this action is reasonable and in the public interest;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Nags Head, North Carolina, that Chapter 48, Zoning, of the Code of Ordinances shall be amended as follows:

PART I. That Section 48-167(3) Parking Requirements – Recreational Uses

Fishing pier	One parking space for each ten feet of length <i>for piers over 800 linear feet in length</i> with one additional parking space for each 200 square feet of gross floor space under cover. <i>One parking space for each 20 feet of pier length for piers 800 linear feet or less in length with one additional parking space for each 200 square feet of gross floor space under cover.</i>
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PART II. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the **5th day of June 2013.**
