



**RESOLUTION TO WAIVE PERMIT FEES
ASSOCIATED WITH HURRICANE MICHAEL
ON OCTOBER 11, 2018**

WHEREAS, Hurricane Michael hit the Outer Banks with strong winds, sound, and eventual ocean
overwash on October 11, 2018; AND

WHEREAS, Storm surge conditions caused major flooding in already-saturated areas in the Town of
Nags Head; AND

WHEREAS, Extreme overwash and strong winds caused property damage to a number of residences
and businesses throughout the Town; AND

WHEREAS, Repairs to damaged structures and reconstruction efforts will require permits along with the
associated reviews and inspections in accordance with Town Code Chapter 10 (Buildings and Building
Regulations) and Chapter 48 (Zoning), AND

WHEREAS, Property owners are normally responsible for paying the permit fees associated with their
home repairs and reconstruction projects; AND


WHEREAS, The Town of Nags Head wants to work with property owners to assist them in making the
necessary repairs to their properties as quickly and as easily as possible; AND


WHEREAS, An ordinance amending Town Code Chapter 32 adopted June 7, 2006 authorizes the Board
to temporarily waive permit fees for a period of 90 days for the repair or reconstruction of structures
damaged/destroyed by a storm event.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Nags Head Board of Commissioners does
hereby waive permit fees for the repair or reconstruction of structures that were damaged during the
recent Hurricane Michael.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the waiver of permit fees associated with the
impacts of Hurricane Michael is effective October 11, 2018 and will expire January 11, 2019.
