Dear Applicant,

Thank you for your interest in working for Nags Head Ocean Rescue in 2019. Attached you will find all of the necessary forms to be completed for new hire.

We are currently accepting applications for 2019, and will continue to accept applications until positions have been filled.

Pre-qualifications for hire include:

- Eighteen years of age
- Possess a valid driver's license
- Pass one mile run test 8:00 minutes or less
- Pass 500 meter swim test 10:00 minutes or less
- Pass pre-employment background check and drug test

Our training camp starts two weeks prior to Memorial Day weekend, May 12<sup>th</sup> - May 24<sup>th</sup>. This training camp is mandatory for all first year guards. You are paid during training camp. Our first day on the beach will then be Saturday, May 25<sup>th</sup>, and the summer season ends on Labor Day, Monday September 2<sup>nd</sup>; preference will be given to applicants that can work for the entire summer season. The summer season is followed by a smaller staffed fall season that runs from Labor Day through to October 15th.

Nags Head Ocean Rescue Lifeguard pay range is \$12-\$16.25 per hour, starting base pay is \$12.00 per hour, or \$12.50 per hour for North Carolina EMT certification.

A housing supplement of \$25 per week is also available for lifeguards who work a minimum of 40 hours per week. Housing is not provided by the lifeguard agency, if accepted for hire it is your responsibility to locate housing. With this being said, we will make reasonable attempts to assist you in locating affordable housing and roommates (other lifeguards) in the area.

End of season bonus available.
