The Nags Head Lightkeeper Award

Description

This award was developed to honor persons who have shaped the image and direction of Nags Head, making significant contributions to the Town through their time, actions, talents and dedication.

Nominees shall be outstanding individuals who have been involved in community service such as boards, commissions, task forces, agencies, volunteer organizations, or community groups (formal and informal, of all kinds) and shall have demonstrated a sustained commitment to our community.

Nominees shall be perceived by the citizens of Nags Head as leaders.

The nominees may have been active in local, county, or state government. Nominees may have served to influence decision-making on issues and may demonstrate, through their civic involvement, how the quality of life in their community has been enhanced.

Nominees may also have been engaged in the arts or commerce in such a way that they have elevated the profile of Nags Head. Or they may have been involved in the development of events (festivals, parades, shows, etc.) which celebrate the town.

Judging Criteria

- The degree to which their services/ actions have made a lasting or meaningful contribution or impact on the Town - 40%
- The length and degree of their service(s) - 20%
- The extent to which their service or action might be considered exemplary or "above and beyond the call of duty" - 20%
- The extent to which their action would be recognized and valued by their peers and other community leaders- 20%
