


### Land Suitability Analysis

Yellow outlined areas represent coastal wetlands or wetlands designated as having exceptional or substantial significance according to the North Carolina Region Evaluation of Wetland Significance (NC CREWS). The existence of these features has resulted in several pocket Class III areas in the composite map of environmental conditions. Many of these wetlands are depicted in developed areas or areas where wetlands conditions may not actually exist. This document recognizes that a cursory analysis was used to develop these datasets and that accurate wetland determinations are completed on a site by site basis.
