##### **Citizen Survey**

The primary purpose of the meeting was to receive additional input from the group regarding the draft Citizen Survey. The survey was emailed to LPG members on January 18, 2006 with revision based on previous meetings, emailed comments, and discussion comments from the LUP group website. Specific suggestions were received from two LPG members and incorporated into the survey handout for the meeting.

Bo Taylor led the discussion of the survey refinements. The discussion followed every section of the survey. The meeting was the final LPG refinement of the survey prior to the February 1, 2006 Board meeting. Additional input will be received via email after the meeting.
