

**PETITION FOR BEACH NOURISHMENT PROJECT
IN THE TOWN OF NAGS HEAD,
NORTH CAROLINA**

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF NAGS HEAD:

- A. We, the undersigned owners of property located within the Nags Head Beach Erosion Control and Flood and Hurricane Works Municipal Service District, Exhibit A, do hereby petition the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Nags Head, pursuant to Article 10A of Chapter 160A of the North Carolina General Statutes, to undertake upon the indicated property the beach nourishment project described in the Draft Environmental Impact Statement located at www.townofnagshead.net, which is incorporated herein by reference (hereinafter, "the Project").
- B. We acknowledge the significant erosion occurring on Nags Head's beach. We believe this erosion is detrimental to the recreational, aesthetic, and economic enjoyment of the beach. We further believe the proposed Project will provide various substantial benefits to us as property owners and to the Town at large, including:
- Protecting our property from additional water and storm damage, which increases with proximity to the ocean, and delaying the movement of our properties into the Public Trust.
- C. It is our desire that the project be implemented on that property within the Nags Head Beach Erosion Control and Flood and Hurricane Works Municipal Service District, identified in Exhibit A (hereinafter "the Property").
- D. With respect to our specific property, we request:
1. That approximately 4.6 million cubic yards of beach-quality sand be excavated from an ocean borrow site.
 2. That the dredged sand be deposited on our property and the Property named in Paragraph C between the toe of the existing dune and the low water line, to be shaped into a profile closely corresponding to the contours and elevations of the natural beach as it exists at the commencement of dredging.
- E. We understand that Town has estimated the total cost of the requested Project to be approximately \$36 million. We understand that, pursuant to the Town's assessment policy, individual assessments are to be made on property owners according to the tax value of their property at the commencement of dredging, in an amount equal to 19.6 cents per \$100 of property value annually for each of five (5) years, totaling 98 cents per \$100 of property value. We further understand that this assessment is expected to account for approximately \$10.1 million, or approximately twenty-eight (28) percent of the estimated total improvement cost.
- F. Pursuant to the assessment power of the Town of Nags Head, established by Article 10A of Chapter 160A of the North Carolina General Statutes, we hereby request and petition the Board of Commissioners to levy a special assessment against the Property benefited by the above Project.

By my signature below, I certify that I am an owner of the address(es), with corresponding parcel number(s) listed below, which is located within the Nags Head Beach Erosion Control and Flood and Hurricane Works Municipal Service District, Exhibit A, and that I support this Petition for all properties in which my name appears on the deed.
