EIGHTH ST. ROADWAY RESURFACE & DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS

PROJECT LIMITS: Southern Half of East and West Eighth Street from Pond Ave. east to South Virginia Dare Trail.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Construction activities have been ongoing since Mid-January and primarily consisting of pavement widening, drainage and intersection improvements and fine grading and surface stabilization along the length of the Eighth St. corridor. Paving operations are currently scheduled to take place on Saturday April 9, 2016 and Monday April 11, 2016., (please note that scheduled dates are weather dependent and are subject to change). This work will entail patching, wedging and the addition of a asphalt surface overlay course along the length of Eighth St. Once the roadway improvements are concluded, pavement striping and other incidental work will follow shortly thereafter completing the scheduled scope of work.



During the period of pavement and striping operations, we request that vehicular and pedestrian traffic exercise caution when traveling through this corridor. Delays and single lane road closures are anticipated while these construction activities are being conducted. Please note that motorists can utilize Satterfield Landing Road to Lark Avenue as an alternate route to access businesses along West
