



**RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE UTILIZATION OF  
NC DEPT OF CORRECTIONS INMATES**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Nags Head, North Carolina supports the utilization of North Carolina Department of Corrections inmates to assist local governments in meeting their increasing service requirements; and

WHEREAS, the North Carolina General Assembly recently passed, and the Governor signed, the state's FY 2010-2011 \$19 billion budget; and

WHEREAS, the adopted budget includes \$1.6 million and 39 positions to re-establish inmate work crews that aid local governments; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Nags Head has greatly benefited from the use of NC Department of Corrections inmate crews in the past; and

WHEREAS, local governments in North Carolina continue to face increasing budget constraints, which have resulted in staffing cuts, but not in the reduction of maintenance and repair responsibilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Nags Head that the North Carolina Department of Corrections quickly fill the authorized positions and re-establish inmate work crews for use by local governments as soon as possible.
