

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF NAGS HEAD, NORTH CAROLINA

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Nags Head, North Carolina, that the Town Code be amended.

**PART I.** That Sec. 2-7. - Authorization for town manager to dispose of certain personal property be amended as follows:

The town manager shall be authorized to dispose of personal property after determining that the item or group of items to be disposed of has a fair market value not to exceed \$5,000.00 \$30,000.00; that the property is no longer necessary for the conduct of public business; and that sound property management principles and financial considerations indicate that the interests of the town would best be served by disposing of the property. It is further provided that upon compliance with this section, the town manager shall have full authority to dispose of surplus personal property.

**PART II.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the **16**<sup>th</sup> day of **September 2019**.
