



**TOWN OF NAGS HEAD
BOC ACTIONS
WEDNESDAY, JULY 19, 2017**

1. Call to order – Mayor Pro Tem Walters called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
 2. Mayor Pro Tem Walters – spoke concerning the first portion of this special meeting which was held on Friday, July 7th at 4 pm; she stated that Board members have always been respectful of each other, even when disagreeing about an issue, except for the July 7th meeting.
 3. Town Attorney Leidy – stated that the July 7th Special Meeting was valid as allowed by the State's Open Meetings law; recessing to today's July 19th Special Meeting was also valid. A formal Public Hearing requires an order by the Board – he read from the Board-adopted Rules of Procedure. He indicated that a public comment period would be appropriate.
 4. Proposed Ordinance – A motion was made and seconded to adopt the ordinance to allow the sale of alcohol beginning at 10 am on Sundays.
 5. Public Comment - Attorney Leidy opened the floor for public comment on the proposed ordinance for those who wished to address the Board on this specific matter. The time was 7:12 p.m.
- The following people spoke in favor of the proposed ordinance: Gus Zinovis, Allen Moran, Beaman Hines, Daniel Lewis, Richard Murphy, Mark Ballog, and Bobbie Stager.
6. Comr. Demers – commented that he never had an issue with the proposed ordinance – his personal feeling was to be in favor of it but at the same time, in keeping with the Board's practices, to allow public comment for anyone interested in speaking concerning it.
 7. Proposed Ordinance – the motion to adopt the ordinance allowing the sale of alcohol beginning at 10 am on Sundays passed 4 – 0 (Mayor Edwards was not present.).
 8. Adjournment – The Board adjourned at 7:33 p.m.
