THIS CONTRACT is made and entered into this the 30th day of October, 2009, by and between the TOWN OF NAGS HEAD, a public body corporate of the State of North Carolina, (hereinafter referred to as "the TOWN") party of the first part and Kevin Carver , (hereinafter referred to as "CONTRACTOR"), party of the second part.

1. SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED AND AGREED CHARGES

The services and/or material to be furnished under this contract (hereinafter referred to collectively as "SERVICES") and agreed charges are as follows:

The services to be performed by contractor under this contract are:

All Labor, Material, Equipment and Services necessary to inspect privately owned conventional "on-site septic" waste systems in Nags Head, NC per the Septic Health Initiative on an as needed basis. These inspections will be performed as and when requested by the Town.

Town shall pay Contractor \$75.00 for each completed inspection. Contractor shall complete each inspection within 30 calendar days from the date the Town orders an inspection.

If Contractor cannot inspect a septic system because of inaccessibility due to obstruction by sand dune, concrete or asphalt, motor vehicles, top soil exceeding two feet in depth or other unforeseen circumstance preventing access, then Town shall pay Contractor \$37.50 to reimburse Contractor for travel and other associated operational costs.

2. DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT

3. TERM OF CONTRACT

The term of this CONTRACT for SERVICES is from October 30, 2009 to June 15, 2010. Either party may nonetheless cancel this contract on thirty (30) days written notice to the other party by certified mail or personal delivery. This contract is subject to the availability of funds to purchase the specified SERVICES and may be terminated at any time if such funds become unavailable.

4. PAYMENT TO CONTRACTOR

The TOWN agrees to pay at the rates specified for SERVICES satisfactorily performed in accordance with this contract. Unless otherwise specified, the CONTRACTOR shall submit an itemized invoice to the TOWN by the end of the month during which SERVICES are performed. Payment will be processed promptly upon receipt and approval by the TOWN of the invoice.

5. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR

Both the TOWN and the CONTRACTOR agree that the CONTRACTOR shall act as an independent contractor and shall not represent itself as an agent or employee of the TOWN for any purpose in the performance of the CONTRACTOR'S duties under this contract. Accordingly, the CONTRACTOR shall be responsible for payment of all Federal, State and local taxes arising out of the CONTRACTOR'S activities in accordance with this contract, including by way of illustration by not limitation, Federal and State income tax, Social Security tax, Unemployment Insurance taxes, and any other taxes or business license fees as required.

In performing the SERVICES, the CONTRACTOR is acting as an independent contractor and shall perform SERVICES in accordance with currently approved methods and practice in the CONTRACTOR'S professional capacity and in accordance with the standards of applicable professional organizations and licensing agencies.

6. INSURANCE AND INDEMNITY

The CONTRACTOR shall indemnify and save harmless the TOWN, its agents and employees from and against all actions, liability, claims, suits, damages, cost or expenses of any kind which may be brought or made against the TOWN or which the TOWN must pay and incur by reason of or in any manner resulting from injury, loss or damage to persons or property resulting from negligent performance of or failure to perform any of its obligations under the terms of this CONTRACT.

The CONTRACTOR shall be fully responsible to the TOWN for the acts and omissions of its sub-contractors and of persons either directly or indirectly employed by it, as the CONTRACTOR is for the acts and omissions of persons directly employed by it.

In addition, the CONTRACTOR shall comply with the North Carolina Worker's Compensation Act and shall provide for the payment of workers' compensation to its employees in the manner and to the extent required by such Act. In the event the CONTRACTOR is excluded from the requirements of such Act and does not voluntarily carry workers' compensation coverage, the CONTRACTOR shall carry or cause its employees to carry adequate medical/accident insurance to cover any injuries sustained by its employees or agents during the performance of SERVICES.





THIS CONTRACT is made and entered into this the 30th day of October, 2009, by and between the TOWN OF NAGS HEAD, a public body corporate of the State of North Carolina, (hereinafter referred to as "the TOWN") party of the first part and Wade Tillett, (hereinafter referred to as "CONTRACTOR"), party of the second part.

1. SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED AND AGREED CHARGES

The services and/or material to be furnished under this contract (hereinafter referred to collectively as "SERVICES") and agreed charges are as follows:

The services to be performed by contractor under this contract are:

All Labor, Material, Equipment and Services necessary to inspect privately owned conventional "on-site septic" waste systems in Nags Head, NC per the Septic Health Initiative on an as needed basis. These inspections will be performed as and when requested by the Town.

Town shall pay Contractor \$75.00 for each completed inspection. Contractor shall complete each inspection within 30 calendar days from the date the Town orders an inspection.

If Contractor cannot inspect a septic system because of inaccessibility due to obstruction by sand dune, concrete or asphalt, motor vehicles, top soil exceeding two feet in depth or other unforeseen circumstance preventing access, then Town shall pay Contractor \$37.50 to reimburse Contractor for travel and other associated operational costs.

2. DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT

Conventional On-site Septic Waste System Inspection

3. TERM OF CONTRACT

The term of this CONTRACT for SERVICES is from October 30, 2009 to June 15, 2010. Either party may nonetheless cancel this contract on thirty (30) days written notice to the other party by certified mail or personal delivery. This contract is subject to the availability of funds to purchase the specified SERVICES and may be terminated at any time if such funds become unavailable.

4. PAYMENT TO CONTRACTOR

The TOWN agrees to pay at the rates specified for SERVICES satisfactorily performed in accordance with this contract. Unless otherwise specified, the CONTRACTOR shall submit an itemized invoice to the TOWN by the end of the month during which SERVICES are performed. Payment will be processed promptly upon receipt and approval by the TOWN of the invoice.

5. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR

Both the TOWN and the CONTRACTOR agree that the CONTRACTOR shall act as an independent contractor and shall not represent itself as an agent or employee of the TOWN for any purpose in the performance of the CONTRACTOR'S duties under this contract. Accordingly, the CONTRACTOR shall be responsible for payment of all Federal, State and local taxes arising out of the CONTRACTOR'S activities in accordance with this contract, including by way of illustration but not limitation, Federal and State income tax, Social Security tax, Unemployment Insurance taxes, and any other taxes or business license fees as required.

In performing the SERVICES, the CONTRACTOR is acting as an independent contractor and shall perform SERVICES in accordance with currently approved methods and practice in the CONTRACTOR'S professional capacity and in accordance with the standards of applicable professional organizations and licensing agencies.

6. INSURANCE AND INDEMNITY

The CONTRACTOR shall indemnify and save harmless the TOWN, its agents and employees from and against all actions, liability, claims, suits, damages, cost or expenses of any kind which may be brought or made against the TOWN or which the TOWN must pay and incur by reason of or in any manner resulting from injury, loss or damage to persons or property resulting from negligent performance of or failure to perform any of its obligations under the terms of this CONTRACT.

The CONTRACTOR shall be fully responsible to the TOWN for the acts and omissions of its sub-contractors and of persons either directly or indirectly employed by it, as the CONTRACTOR is for the acts and omissions of persons directly employed by it.
